EVERYONE MUST PARTICIPATE IN SHOWMANSHIP

- All exhibitors that are members of the Tri-County area clubs ages 9-21 in 4-H or FFA are eligible to participate.
- Division awards to be presented. Ribbons will be awarded to entries in all classes. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, place winners will be awarded prize money.
- Dress code applies for all classes
- All 4-H and FFA members competing in the Tri-County 4-H and FFA Horse Show will be required to wear approved protective headgear, including in the ring and on the fairgrounds during the show.
- Premier Exhibitor Award will be presented. This will combine 1 Division, skill-a-thon points, and showmanship. You may compete in as many divisions as desired, however only the highest will count towards Premier Exhibitor. One horse per division.
- Skill-a-thon will be available on horse show day for exhibitors to participate.
- Points will be scored as follow: 1st/5, 2nd/4, 3rd/3, 4th/2 and 1 point for each participant.
- Please mail copy of Coggin's with entry.
- Pre-registration is required. See front for deadlines.

Class Descriptions & Order

- **Senior Fitting & Showmanship** (14 years and older) Halter (Western) or Bridle (English)
 - **Junior Fitting & Showmanship** (13 years and younger) Halter (Western) or Bridle (English)
 - **Mini Jumps**
 - **Mini Obstacle**
 - **English Equitation** (hunt seat and saddle seat) Riders judged on equitation and suitability of horse and rider.
 - **Plantation Horsemanship** (walk and easy gait) Rider judged on equitation and suitability of horse and rider.
 - **Western Horsemanship** - Rider judged on equitation and suitability of horse and rider.
 - **English Pleasure** (hunt seat and saddle seat) Judged on pleasurability, suitability for horse, rider and quality of movement.
 - **Plantation Pleasure** (walk and easy gait) Judged on pleasurability, suitability for horse, rider and quality of movement.
 - **Western Pleasure** (walk/jog/lope) Judged on pleasurability, suitability for horse, rider and quality of movement.
 - **Cart Class** (driving)
 - **Plantation Command** (walk/easy gait/canter) A horse and rider combination must be performing the gait correctly. Three strides will be allowed of transition.
 - **Western Command** (walk/jog/lope) A horse and rider combination must be performing the gait correctly. Three strides will be allowed of transition.
 - **English Command** (walk/trot/canter) A horse and rider combination must be performing the gait correctly. Three strides will be allowed of transition.
 - **Barrel Race** (timed event) cloverleaf pattern
 - **Pole Bending** (timed event)
 - **50-yard Dash** (timed event)
- NOTE: Speed Classes will be JULY 30th at 6pm! Remainder of classes will be JULY 31st!**
- NOTE: Class Numbers for Saturday are beside the class picked!**

Note: 4-H and Open Show will be combined and ran consecutively. Make note what classes you are entered, so you have them on show day!
