**Rules:**

**FEES**

- \$5 grounds fee per horse
- Regular Classes \$7 Payback 10,8,6,4, R, R
- Jackpot Classes (in **BOLD**) \$15 Payback 70%
- Stalls - \$10 for the day, \$25 for Friday Night and Saturday Stalls are FREE on Sunday ONLY to 4-H and FFA members.
- Hook ups available, but generators encouraged!

**Rules:**

- Show management reserves the right to pay 2nd place payouts on classes with less than 3 entries.
- Helmets are required for anyone under 18
- All riders of horses must be physically suited for the mount or be disqualified.
- Decision of the Judge and/or Chairman is final.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES permitted on the grounds.
- The Tri-County Fair Association will not be responsible for death, injury, theft, or property damage.
- A two-minute gate call will be enforced. Please request tack changes at least two classes ahead.
- Any horses or ponies that cannot be kept under control will be excused from the ring.
- No smoke on grounds by order of the Grant County Health Department.
- Contest exhibitors will not be allowed to run off the gate. The gate must be closed, and the horse must have a change of direction before they are allowed to run the pattern.
- Pee wee exhibitors will not be allowed to cross enter the youth classes.
- Youth exhibitors will not be allowed to cross enter the adult class.
- Open Horses will be permitted to arrive at the Fairgrounds Friday, July 21 between 2 p.m. and 8 p.m. 4-H horses may arrive after 5pm on July 22.
- Horses arriving Saturday, July 30 may arrive anytime. Horses staying overnight Saturday must leave grounds by 9 a.m. on Sunday.
- Registration will begin Friday afternoon at 3:00pm until the start of the show.
- Registration will begin Saturday morning at 7:30am until the start of the show
- Waiver to be signed at check-in.
- Proof of negative Coggins must be presented at registration.
- Ribbons are awarded in each class.
- Ranch Horses may not cross-enter Western (pleasure type) classes and vice versa.
- Plantation horses may not cross-enter trot/jog classes.
- Dress codes for each discipline will be adhered too
