- Stalls - \$10 for the day, \$25 for Friday Night and Saturday
Stalls are FREE on Sunday ONLY to 4-H and FFA members.
- Hook ups available, but generators encouraged!

Rules:

- Show management reserves the right to pay 2nd place payouts on classes with less than 5 entries.
- Helmets are required for anyone 17 and under.
- Decision of the Judge and/or Chairman is final.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES permitted on the grounds.
- The Tri-County Fair Association will not be responsible for death, injury, theft, or property damage.
- A two-minute gate call will be enforced. Please request tack changes at least two classes ahead.
- Any horses or ponies that cannot be kept under control will be excused from the ring.
- No smoking on grounds by order of the Grant County Health Department.
- Pee wee exhibitors will not be allowed to cross enter the youth classes.
- Youth exhibitors will not be allowed to cross enter the adult class.
- No rules on cross entering ranch and western.
- Registration will begin Saturday morning at 8am until the start of the show. Speed registration will start at 4:00pm
- Speed Show will not start before 5pm
- Waiver to be signed at check-in.
- Proof of negative Coggins must be presented at registration.
- Ribbons are awarded in each class.
- Dress codes for each discipline will be adhered too
- No entry fee for Lead line.
- Will require 5 entries to set trail course, with a 15-entry max on trail class (First come, First serve). Will be a time limit.
- VERSATILITY IS BACK. Classes will include: 1, 13, 20, 31. Best combined score of all 4 classes will receive prize!
